Format your reference list entry in the following format if you are citing an author whose work you accessed over the Internet: Author's Last Name, First Initial, Title (in italics), (full web address), Day Month, Year of access. If the author's name isn't listed, simply use the phrase "Author unknown."

The information below is for MLA style in citing a genetics lab manual: If the lab manual was created by a staff member or department of the school and is only available through class, cite it as an unpublished work. The rules for in-text citations will be the same. If a department prepared the manual, use it for the name in the citation.

## **How do I cite a science lab manual for a report? - Ask Us!**

Reference Lab Billing for the Lab Service. The lab should bill the appropriate lab CPT code (8XXXX). In box 24b on the CMS 1500 claim form, enter place of service 81. The physician may bill for specimen handling (CPT 99000 or CPT 99001) or venipuncture (CPT 36415) when appropriate. A reference entry for a report, and other gray literature, will contain the the following source details: Author name; Date published. Either year (2020) or year, month day (2020, February 14) Title of the work (in sentence case) Associated number (if applicable). Examples: Report No. 22, Project No. 567, Issue 101, etc. Work description (if needed).

References Page Formatting. References follow the text in a section headed REFERENCES (use first-level head format identified earlier). All references should be double-spaced and use a hanging indent. Use title case for all titles (capitalize all words except prepositions such as of, between, through ), articles (such as a, the, and an ), and conjunctions (such as but, and, or; however, capitalize them if they begin the title or the subtitle).

Each source you cite in the paper must appear in your reference list; likewise, each entry in the reference list must be cited in your text. Your references should begin on a new page separate from the text of the essay; label this page "References" in bold, centered at the top of the page (do NOT underline or use quotation marks for the title).
