Differentiated Comprehension Questions for The Paper Bag ...
Read The Paper Bag Princess to your class. After reading the story, ask your students some comprehension questions to assess their understanding of the story. Good examples include: Who was brave (strong, clever) in the story? Who was unkind in the story? What makes a good friend? How can you be a good friend? What is the author trying to teach us?
